## **CBA Highlights**

- ? **Brackets will stay the same** - \$10 each with 4 sessions during qualifying and the proceeds benefiting the Mike Light Jr MJBT/CBA Baker Doubles tournament to be held in January, 2005.
- ? **Mini Eliminator** – we will run a mini eliminator at a cost of \$10 with 2 sessions during the qualifying with 10% taken out and used for the MJBT fund.
- ? **Recruit-A-Bowler** – Any CBA member who recruits a first time bowler will receive a \$20 discount off of their entry fee. The first time bowler will pay only \$75 and that entry fee will stay the same until that bowler cashes. Board members will give the \$20 to the first time bowler therefore reducing the entry fee to \$55.
- ? **Reduced Entries** – Our reduced entries will stay the same. \$75 for a first time bowler and stays \$75 until they cash. They will, however, have to pay the \$40 annual membership or the \$15 non-member fee after the 1<sup>st</sup> tournament. \$90 for a bowler not cashing in the last 4 tournaments they have bowled but must be within the last 2 years. \$110 for everyone else.
- ? **Jackpots & Bet You’ll Win** – Stays at \$10.
- ? **Bowlers making the cut and cashing ratio** – The cashing ratio of 1 for 3 will remain the same. The number of bowlers making the cut will be: 8 for 35 entries or less, 12 for 36-47, 16 for 48 to 59, 20 for 60 to 71 and 24 for 72 and over. The year-end will stay the same with the top 24 guaranteed to make the cut regardless of entries.

## Scott Pohl Wins Year-End Tournament for 8<sup>th</sup> CBA Title

**Scott Pohl** started out the Sunday match play at the year-end tournament at AMF Village North with games of 267-288-246 for 801 and never looked back. He led the entire way and had to fight off a determined **John Kreyer Jr** in the championship match. After 2 splits in the first 3 frames by Kreyer and an open frame in the 6<sup>th</sup> by Pohl, the match was within 20 pins. Pohl showed his championship stuff with a late turkey and went on to win 220-158 for his 8<sup>th</sup> CBA title and 2<sup>nd</sup> Year-End Title.

Kreyer was determined to get another shot at a title, he was 2<sup>nd</sup> at the US Open in December at AMF Earle Brown, as he disposed of **Chad Nelson** in the semi final match 230-206. The first stepladder match had **David Langer** up against **Chad Huikko**. Both bowlers struggled early and a late four-bagger by Huikko gave him the win 210-184. Nelson then took care of Huikko 214-174 to bowl against Kreyer.

**Carl Fietek** came on strong toward the end of the season to win another CBA Bowler of the Year. His 6<sup>th</sup> overall and 5<sup>th</sup> in the last 7 years. Chad Nelson won the \$300 from Mikes Pro Shop for winning the CBA Points Challenge. He garnered the most points in the Eau Claire, US Open and Year-End tournaments. Fietek with a 299 and Nelson with an 803 had the only other honor scores. **Sam Lantto** was the Qualifying Leader with plus-414 (241 avg.) Jeff Clapp won the "**On Track Casher**" which gives him a free entry into the June CBA tournament. **Dan Bock** stopped a string of 18 consecutive cashes by finishing out of the money.

**Clark Poelzer** came out on top in the River Liquor Store shootout and took home the \$400 1<sup>st</sup> place prize. **Jeff Anderson** was 2<sup>nd</sup> for \$300, **Dan Bock** 3rd for \$200 and **David Oulman** 4<sup>th</sup> for \$100. David Oulman also took the CBA Rookie of the Year honors, beating out **Matt Kirkham**.

Special thanks to **Paul Manthei** and his staff at AMF Village North Lanes for their hospitality in hosting our tournament. Also thanks to **Bob & Diane Marget** for sponsoring the shootout for the 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive year.
