**Alternate Shot/Scotch Doubles Format**

**Saturday Qualifying** - There will be 16 games of Alternate Shot doubles with a break after 8 games for lunch. Bowlers decide who will start the 1<sup>st</sup> game and will alternate shots for the next 8 games. At the start of the 2<sup>nd</sup> block bowlers will again decide who will start and then alternate shots for the next 8 games. No bowler can throw back to back shots at any time. Who ever throws the final ball in the 10<sup>th</sup> frame cannot start the next game. (Except from game 8 to game 9).

**Sunday Match Play** – The top 8 or 12 teams will bowl 2 game matches followed by a stepladder. 35 entries or less top 8 make the cut and 36 or more top 12 make the cut.

CBA Logo patches will be available at all tournaments. All members & non-members must have a CBA logo displayed on their shirt or they must purchase a patch for \$7.00. All bowlers must have their names and CBA logos on their shirts for both days and no bowlers are allowed to wear jeans on Sundays. A \$10.00 fine will be issued for bowlers late for paddock on Sunday. Paddock is always at 7:40 AM.

**Only 2 more tournaments left to qualify for the Big Added Money Year End CBA!!**

The 2006-2007 Year End CBA will be held at Cedarvale Lanes in Eagan. Bowlers must be a member for this season and have bowled in 4 tournaments to be eligible. The payout will be 1 for 2 and there will be approximately \$4000 Added Money for this tournament.

## Bob Hager Repeats at Holiday Lanes for 2<sup>nd</sup> CBA Title

Owatonna's **Bob Hager** dominated the Sunday Match Play at Holiday Lanes in Albert Lea on his way to his 2<sup>nd</sup> CBA title with back-to-back victories at the annual February stop. Hager had to take on his teammate **Tom Korth** in the championship match and it was quite a battle until a late open by Korth had Hager just needing to fill the 10<sup>th</sup> to win 237-222. With a near record setting performance, Hager knocked down 3040 pins (253 avg) for the 12 match play games, and won 10 matches to be plus 940. Another teammate of Hager's, **Dan Bock**, holds the record for the 12 game match play actual pinfall with 3107 (258) and plus 1037 set in 2003 at Holiday Lanes.

The stepladder started with CBA Hall of Famer **Brad Larson** taking on **Mark Lutchens**, who was making his first stepladder appearance while making the cut for the first time. Both bowlers were clean but Lutchens could only manage a double while Larson had a turkey for a 218-201 victory. Larson then had to take on Korth and while he did have another turkey he also had 2 opens to Korth's clean game and Korth prevailed 216-194. Korth then had to take on his teammate and current Bowler of the Year leader, **Chad Nelson**. Not wanting to give Nelson a chance Korth started the match with the front 7 while Nelson had an open in the 3<sup>rd</sup> frame. A split and open frame in the 8<sup>th</sup> for Korth and a six-bagger by Nelson had Korth needing to fill the 10<sup>th</sup> for the victory and he calmly struck to win 255-237 and set up the championship match.

45 bowlers took the trip to Albert Lea and Chad Nelson was the Qualifying Leader with a score of 2191 (219 avg), while it took 1976 (197 avg) to make the top 14 cut and last cash was 1965 (196 avg). The bonus senior casher went to Mankato's **Dale Seath** with 1935 (193 avg) and **Brent Stearns** held off all opponents in the 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> frame eliminator rolloff for the "*On Track Casher*" and a free entry into the April CBA tournament.

Once again we had a great number of first time bowlers in **Ryan Burr, Tom Johnson, Brett Pfeifer, Tim Kroneman, Matt Rassmussen, Travis Guy, Dusty Olson, Bill Wagner, Jamie Brandt** and **Pete Conway**.

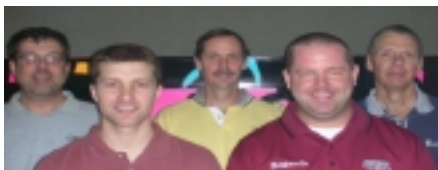
