Only 1 more tournament left to qualify for the Big Added Money Year End CBA!!

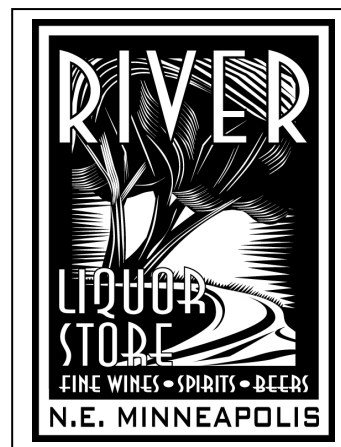

Langer Brothers Win Another Doubles Title – Alternate Shot

David & Dan Langer won the Baker Doubles tournament last October, and were victorious in the first ever Alternate Shot Doubles tournament held at AMF Earle Brown Lanes in March 2007. Seeded first going into the stepladder finals, the Langers had to face the formidable duo of **Richard Vitko & Bob Hager** once again, as they did in the Baker Doubles. The result was the same as they had a 12 pin lead after the first game 236-224 and proceeded to strike at will for a 265 in the 2nd game and won the 2 game total pins match 501-461. This is the 8th CBA title for David, third this season in which he has only bowled 3 tournaments, and the 2nd for Dan in which he has only bowled 2 tournaments.

The first stepladder match had **Sam Lantto & Jason Smith** against **Scott Stearns & Jeff Walther**. Lantto/Smith shot 241 to Stearns/Walther's 204 in game 1 and finished them off 435-382. Vitko/Hager were too much for Lantto/Smith as they took care of them 490-392 to have another chance at a doubles title.

35 teams entered this unique tournament and Lantto/Smith were qualifying leaders at 3570 (223 avg) for the 16 games of alternate shots (no bowler could throw back-to-back shots). It took a score of 3413 (213 avg) to make the cut and 3397 (212 avg) to cash. **Tim Hoke & Ron Lindner** won the bonus senior cash spot.

With 2 tournaments to go we have a race for Bowler of the Year with **Chad Nelson** leading **Dan Bock** by 27 points and The Rookie of the Year is even closer with **Seth Bonow** leading **Mark Lutichens** by 9 points. The Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge has Nelson leading **Jeff Smith** by 4 points and Bock by 5. The points challenge combines the points won in the Linds Invitational, The November CBA, The U S open and the Year End and wins \$300 from Mike Pro Shop.

The CBA would like to thank AMF Earle Brown Lanes manager **Steve Pulka**, Head Mechanic **Scott Sodergren** and their staff for hosting our tournament.
