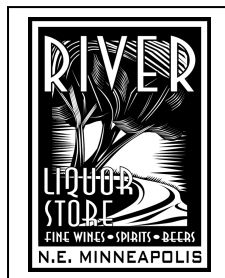

Dave Oulman Wins U S Open for 1st CBA Title

Owatonna's **Dave Oulman** has been bowling almost every tournament since he was Rookie of the Year for the 2003-2004 season (he is currently on a 36 consecutive tournament streak). As the 12 game US Open Qualifying Leader, Oulman fought his way to be the 2nd seed heading into the stepladder finals during Sunday's match play. With Little Falls' **Jeff Smith** as the top seed, Oulman knew he had his hands full and would have to bowl a great game to win. Starting the match with Turkey-Spare-Strike, Oulman had a 19 pin lead in the 6th frame. Smith, trying to win back-to-back CBA tournaments, wasn't going to let him off that easily. A double by Smith in the 7th & 8th and an open frame by Oulman in the 8th had Smith up by 4 pins but Oulman had struck in the ever important 9th frame. Smith finished first and made Oulman get the first strike in the 10th for the win. With the US Open title and his first CBA championship on the line, Oulman came through with a perfect strike to claim victory by a score of 213-206 and will represent Minnesota in the BPAA US Open.

In the first stepladder match we had Brooklyn Park's **David Langer** against Crystal's **Mike Skinner**. A back and forth match had Skinner, with a late turkey forcing Langer to get the 1st strike in the 10th to win. A stubborn 4-pin had Skinner moving on 219-214. Skinner couldn't quite keep it going in the next match as he faced Eden Prairie's **Carl Fietek** with Fietek coming away the winner 183-174. Fietek had to face Oulman in the semifinal match with Oulman staying clean for a 225-222 win.

Dave Oulman's Qualifying Leader score was 2735 (227.9 avg) for the 12 games while it took a score of 2520 (210 avg) to make the cut and 2519 (209.9 avg) to cash. **Ron Lindner** was the bonus senior casher with 2492 (207.6 avg) and **Dan Bock** took on everybody in the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff to win the "*On Track Casher*" and a free entry into the January CBA tournament at Granite Bowl South.

David Langer has 54 points and **Jeff Smith** has 52 through the first 3 tournaments of the Mikes Pro Shop CBA Points Challenge. With only the Year End tournament to go the \$300 prize is still up for grabs.

A huge thank you goes to **Keith Hinrichs** and his staff at Memory Lanes for hosting our US Open tournament. We would also like to thank the Minnesota Bowling Proprietors for paying the entry into the National BPAA US Open tournament.
