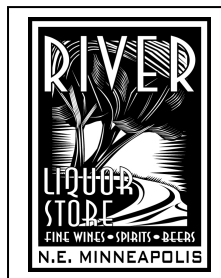

Rob Clements Wins at New Hope Bowl for 1st CBA Title

Rob Clements of Plymouth took on his team captain, **Tom Korth**, in the championship match at the CBA's 1st tournament of the 2009-2010 season at New Hope Bowl and came away with his first CBA title. Qualifying 5th after the 8 games of qualifying and seeded 2nd after the 6 match play games, Clements had a five-bagger in the middle of the championship game while Korth was having a little trouble. The end result was a 235-177 victory for his title.

The first stepladder match had **Dan Bock** against Junior Bowler **Nick Pahr** making his first stepladder appearance in only his 2nd tournament. Bock, the soon to be CBA Hall of Famer, won easily 237-156. Another bowler making his first stepladder appearance was **Jeff Moos**, who started the day with a 299 and was the qualifying leader at plus 339, was up next for Bock. Bock had an early double and late four-bagger to put away Moos 234-185. The semi final match was down to the 10th as Clements needed a double in the 10th to shut out Bock but only managed the first strike and spare. Bock, needing to double to win left a stubborn 7 pin on the first shot and Clements won 204-198.

Moos was the qualifying leader at plus 339 (242 avg) as it took a score of 1667 (208 avg) to cash and make the cut. **Mike Skinner** won the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff for the *"On Track Casher"* and a free entry into the July CBA tournament.
