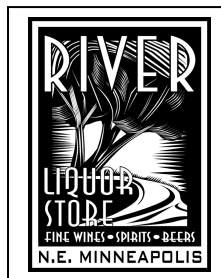

The 17th annual CBA Hall of Fame and Awards banquet will be held at Cedarvale Lanes on Saturday October 31st after the completion of the Baker Doubles qualifying. **Dan Bock** will be inducted for Superior Performance. We will be honoring all CBA champions from the past year and also the members of the All Star teams, Bowler of the Year, Rookie of the Year, John Dorek Award winner, Jim Lindquist high average award winner and the Bob Hanson Sportsmanship Award winner. The dinner is **Free** to all CBA members; cost for guests is \$13. There will be door prizes that everyone will have a chance to win, so make sure you show up and congratulate everyone on their accomplishments.



Matt Smallin Comes Away Victorious at Linds Invitational at Brunswick Zone

Matt Smallin made the trip from Minot, ND to compete in only his 4th CBA tournament at the 10th Annual “Linds Invitational Tournament” at Brunswick Zone in Brooklyn Park and came away with the victory. Bowling against **Arnie Gerdes** in the championship match, Smallin started with a turkey followed by 2 – 10 pins which he missed the 2nd one. That left an opening for Gerdes to catch up and the match was within 1 pin in the 5th. Smallin had a four-bagger in the 6th through 9th frames while Gerdes went spare-turkey. Gerdes was up first in the 10th and needed to strike out to force Smallin to get the 1st strike but a 4-7-9 split stopped him. Smallin, only needed good count, threw a double for a 256-211 win and his first CBA Title.

Gerdes was up against **Dan Bock**, who will be inducted into our CBA Hall of Fame this month, in the first stepladder match. A tough battle between two of the CBA’s better bowlers had Gerdes coming out on top 256-222. Next up for Gerdes was **Robert Slayton**, who was making only his 2nd CBA singles stepladder, and both bowlers ran into some split trouble with Gerdes holding on for a 202-164 win. It wasn’t any easier for Gerdes as he had to face the reigning Bowler of the Year in **Chad Nelson** in the semi final match. With each bowler having a big split early in the match, Gerdes was able to get one more turkey than Nelson and took care of him 217-204 to set up the championship match.

Dan Bock was the qualifying leader with a score of 2367 (236 avg) including a 300 game and 810 series in games 7-8&9. It took a score of plus 115 by **Greg Seath** (who made the cut for the first time) to make the cut and Ryan Burr was the last cash at plus 112. **Kyle Bischoff** at plus 251 also made the cut for the first time. **Tracey Magnuson** took home the bonus woman casher and the senior bonus casher was won by **Ron Lindner**. **Jason Hanson** won the 9th & 10th frame eliminator rolloff for the “*On Track Casher*” and a free entry into the October tournament.

We would like to thank General Manager **Jeremy Marthaler**, **Gail Corbett** and the entire staff at Brunswick Zone for hosting our CBA tournament.
